### **Project Description**

Create a short (7-10sec.), compelling motion piece that promotes an issue you care about, conveyed through a simple message of action or awareness. Imagine you are designing this content to be widely distributed across many different channels.

# **Project Idea**

Be Posi+ive

Short animation about body positivity in people and the possible effects of positive language when heard from a young age.

#### Concept

Voiceover of a young voice saying positive messages about how much they love their body in a Dr. Suessian style rhyme.

Overlay this with images of different adult-aged people with positive smiles as plus (+) signs spring out like confetti.

Final sentiment of "Be Positive. Little ears are listening." over the last frame.

Voiceover Text: Young girl's voice

I love my eyes.
I love my thighs.
I love my nose
And my elbows.
I love my lips.
I love my hips.
I love my hair
It's out to there... [fade out]
